Who are we

- The Tuggeranong Archery Club is one of the largest archery clubs in Australia
- The club was formed over 10 years ago in the Australian Capital Territory in the grassed paddock behind the Tuggeranong Enclosed Oval.
- The Tuggeranong Archery Club provides the opportunity for anyone in the community to 'Come and Try' archery every Sunday morning where all equipment and professional coaching is provided.
- The Club is able to provide Outdoor Target, Field, Clout and with the building of the Multi-use Sporting Facility Indoor Target in accordance with the international Archery Federation (FITA) and Australian Archery Inc..
- Our membership includes international judges, accredited coaches and world ranked archers of various disciplines.
- The Club has hosted 2 national target competitions, a national indoor competition, state indoor, target, clout and indoor competitions.
- State and national competitions are hosted under affiliations with Archery ACT and Archery Australia respectively.
- The Club is now providing facilities, coaching and equipment to many disabled athletes through the new indoor facility and the recently constructed wheel chair path on the main shooting range.
- The club supports and offers memberships for the medieval archers from the International Society of Creative Anachronism, a society dedicated to the preservation of archery, heraldry and all things noble from the days of yore (prior to the 1700's).
- The Club supports twilight and night archery for those who are unable to train during daylight due to the recently installed light towers.
- The Tuggeranong Archery Club provides financial support to the ACT Boccia

- Establish issues to be addressed in the four year plan



Issue 1 – Access to Car Parking Facilities

Main Carpark

- **Storm water from the Centrelink site flows through the main parking area causing flooding and damage to access and parking bays**
- **No all-weather disabled parking**
- **No level all-weather access to the carpark**
- **The need to install drainage pipes to level the carpark**
- **No adequate lane and parking bay markings**
- **No adequate emergency vehicle access**

Field course Carpark

- **Very limited parking on the field course**
- **No disabled access to the field course**
- **Access to the field course is through car pooling**
- **Severe damage to the access track from storm water overflows**
- **Poor access for service vehicles**
- **No adequate access for Emergency vehicles**
- **Need for drainage pipe work**



Issue 2 – Archery facilities and ranges

Main Range

- **Install electronic access control to main ranges and field course.**
- **Replace inadequate fencing with security fences.**
- **Purchase a commercial mower with a 16' to 20' cut or bobcat/tractor with slasher**
- **Install adequate drainage and pipework to alleviate flooding.**
- **Levelling of target ranges to remove trip hazards.**
- **Levelling of shooting lines to remove trip hazards.**
- **Install cabling for timing device**
- **Re-profiling of the arrow trap to enhance the safety level**
- **Replace boundary fencing and warning signs recently vandalised**

Field Range

- **Install electronic access control to Ranges including field course.**
- **Install adequate drainage and pipework to alleviate flooding.**
- **Re-profiling of access road to allow better access**
- **In conjunction with ACT Rangers initiate a sustainable planting regime**
- **In conjunction with ACT Rangers improve the erosion control**
- **Improve target marking and numbering**
- **Improve access to target 1 through 12 to provide for wheel chair access**
- **Purchase a commercial mower with a 16' to 20' cut or bobcat/tractor with slasher**



Clout Range

- **Install electronic access control to Clout field.**
- **Install adequate drainage and pipework to alleviate flooding.**
- **Purchase a commercial mower with a 16' to 20' cut or bobcat/tractor with slasher**
- **Re-profiling of access road to allow better access**
- **In conjunction with ACT Rangers initiate a sustainable planting regime**
- **In conjunction with ACT Rangers improve the erosion control**



Issue 3 – Multi-use Sporting Facility

Indoor Archery Range

- **Develop a plan to maintain and repair target butts**
- **Develop a replacement program for the target butts**
- **Upgrade lighting to Energy Efficient and Environmentally friendly LED High-bay lights**
- **Purchase a floor scrubber to clean and maintain the rubberized sports floor to a safe standard**
- **Purchase a Scissor lift for maintenance programs**

Main Hall General Sporting use

- **Provide a safe sporting facility the various sports in the Tuggeranong Valley**
- **Develop a plan to maintain and repair program**
- **Maintain a sufficient funding supply for all maintenance and replacement works**
- **Upgrade lighting to Energy Efficient and Environmentally friendly LED High-bay lights**
- **Purchase a floor scrubber to clean and maintain the rubberised sports floor to a safe standard**
- **Purchase a Scissor lift for maintenance programs**
- **Ensure cleaning contracts provide good value and sustain a suitable standard**
- **Install wheel chair access to second floor meeting rooms**
- **Install heating and cooling as originally envisaged**



Tuggeranong Archery Club

Multi-use Sports Hall External areas

- **Provide a safe access to the hall and workshops**
- **Complete drainage requirements to reduce flooding**
- **Complete Landscaping of the external areas**
- **Upgrade Security with the introduction of electronic access to all users and CCTV coverage of various areas**
- **Maintain a sufficient funding supply for all maintenance and replacement works**
- **Complete paving and installation of outdoor cooking and eating areas**
- **Upgrade lighting to Energy Efficient and Environmentally friendly LED flood lights**

Archery Workshop

- **Upgrade Security by installation of a CCTV system**
- **Complete installation of hoist**
- **Replace existing mezzanine fence with appropriate safety fence that allows hoist access**
- **Install Archery equipment**
- **Upgrade lighting**
