Now that you're a full member or thinking about becoming one, why not take advantage of what the club has to offer you.

24/7 access to the ranges

The TAC offers its full members the opportunity to hire a swipe key providing you with 24/7 access to the main ranges and workshop.

In the evening the main range has 2 light towers which provide floodlighting to the main range in an inverted V with the longest distance in the center of the range.

Your swipe tag also grants you access to the club workshop located at the south end of the main building.

Workshop access

The workshop provides members with equipment for bow maintenance, arrow making and repairs, a kitchenette and bathroom amenities. Target faces are located under the stairs.

To apply for a swipe tag, simply complete an Access Request form from the Canteen and pay the \$25 deposit fee which is fully refunded on return of the swipe tag.



Access - Swiping your security tag on the reader unlocks the door and deactivates the alarm

Securing - To secure workshop swipe your tag twice, this will secure the door and reactivate the security system.

Alarm set - to confirm that the alarm is set the blue light above the door will flash.







In the workshop you will find archery equipment including:

- A Compound bow press
- Arrow cutter
- Fletching Jig, etc



Club programs

Progressing on from the 'Come and Try', TAC provides a number of programs for members interested in shooting socially or competitively.

- OzBow is the second step in Archery Australia Pathways Program following 'Come and Try'. The program provides athletes with the opportunity and tools to advance from basic beginner all the way to high performance competitor.

- Bhutanese Traditional archery



Purple - low poundage bows

Grey - Medium poundage bows

Brown - High poundage bows


The western range is the overflow and SCA range.



Your Dashboard will be displayed - Below







Click on Register - Dashboard

Click on the Next button - Above




The 'Confirm' will pop-up click NO unless you wish to register for an AA event. - Left
