INFORMATION REGARDING THE EVENT.

Please be aware that there is wildlife on the ranges at Tuggeranong Archery Club (in particular snakes and kangaroos) Do not approach any of the wildlife.

There will be assistance dogs at the event, please be aware that they are not pets and should not be approached without permission.

Parking

Parking for Youth Nationals will be at the AFL Oval next door to the Archery Club. Please follow the signs and advice from our volunteers regarding where to park.

Drop off for competitors will be available at the club. Only Officials, VIP and Disabled Parking will be available in the Archery Car Park throughout Youth Nationals.

Spectators

Spectator areas will be designated on the main range. **NO SPECTATORS** or **TEAM MANAGEMENT** are allowed on the Field Course during shooting.

Due to having reached our maximum capacity for participants the spectator areas will need to be moved around during the event. We understand that this is inconvenient, but it is to ensure safety for all involved.
